The heavy metals lead, cadmium, mercury or hexavalent chromium are not deliberately added nor are they present to the best of our knowledge in any raw materials used in their manufacture. We have also received certification from our raw material suppliers that the virgin grade product 6000 using PCN 205 does not contain Phthalates nor are they deliberately added.

The plastic used for medallion backs, the backs for the rectangles, and the backs for the squares is a high impact black polystyrene plastic. Our supplier has received certification from their supplier that the virgin material they sell does not contain lead, cadmium, mercury or hexavalent chromium nor do they deliberately add these heavy metals during their manufacturing process. This is also true for phthalates.

However, the material we use is a utility grade plastic. Recycled plastic is used in the utility grade and our supplier can not assure us that the recycled plastic does not contain some heavy metals or phthalates. Because of this, your company should not sell the products that use the black plastic to markets that target children 12 years old and under or request virgin material. There will be an increase in price for the virgin material.

This does not apply to the Versa-Back. The Versa-Back uses virgin plastic.
